

The Bishop's Committee of Grace Episcopal Church met in the Guild Hall on Feb. 3, 1961, at 7:30 P.M.

Mr. Swain reported on the sale of a Cadillac car given us by Dr. Lillard. Mr. Bill Newcomb sold it for \$1710., taking in trade an Oldsmobile, which he sold for \$395.

It was moved and seconded to put the sum of \$2105. in a trust account at the Security Bank - to be called Grace Episcopal Trust Account.

The secretary was asked to write thanking Mr. Newcomb for his donation of his commission, cleaning the cars, etc. and to Dr. Lillard.

There was a discussion of fire extinguishers, as advised by the fire marshal. There was a motion to have Bob Payne choose 2 (one for the sanctuary and one for the kitchen) to be purchased when the treasury permits.

There was a motion that the Bishop's Committee pay the additional \$60. on Mr. Swain's salary - from \$1760 to \$1820.
