

# Bishop's Committee Meeting Minutes

March 24, 1966

Present were B. Newcomb, D. Hackett, F. Sly,  
J. Congdon, and C. Bowes.

It was reported that the vicarage had been rented to Merlin David on a 7-month verbal ~~agreed~~ agreement, that is from Apr. 1 to Nov. 1, 1966. Rent is \$90.00 per month, payable on the 1<sup>st</sup>. A 60-day notice was agreed upon.

A meeting will be held Apr. 14 at 8:00 in the Sined Hall with the Bishop's Committee of Howard and Flondreau if they wish to discuss a merger of the 3 churches.

Ten cents a mile was decided upon as travel expense for Father Russell, based on a 70-mile round trip to our services. Jim Congdon is to get a large trash barrel and Bill Newcomb will see about once-a-month trash pickup. Merlin Hunter will see Farmer's Lumber about the repair needed on the front doors of the church.

Convocation delegates will pay their fees and give Dean Hackett the bid. The Committee members will be listed as alternates to the Convocation with Lavina Engelhorn and Carolyn Bowes as delegates.

Mae Doran will be contacted about ~~fixing~~ the door to the belfry to cut the draft and about the hole in the foundation and the weak places in the spire.

From the Memorial Fund, the Ranchos ordered 10 hymnals. They also want some suggestions for permanent items needed in the church. Bill will ask Walt Kelly about raising enough money to buy carpeting.
