To the Bishop's Committee:

At our last Bishop's Committee meeting, we agreed to establish several Standing Committees in the church, each of which would have oversight of a particular area of ministry in the church. It is proposed that each member of the Bishop's Committee serve as a liason on one committee and that the membership of these committees come from the congregation. Listed below are the proposed committees and a brief description of goals and objectives of each committee. At our next meeting (October 15), you will be asked to choose which committee(s) you wish to serve on.

#### BUDGET AND FINANCE

- 1. Work with the Treasurer in providing monthly financial statements for the Bishop's Committee.
- 2. Prepare the annual budget.
- 3. Long-range forecasting and planning.
- 4. Oversee all church funds, e.g. ECW, Memorial Account, Dockendorff bequest.
- 5. Prepare annual Diocesan parochial report.

#### STEWARDSHIP

- 1. Conduct annual Every-Member Canvass.
- 2. Discern the particular gifts and talents of Grace Church members.
- 3. Assist in articulating the mission of Grace Church.

### BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS

- 1. Oversight of improvements and maintenance of the church property.
- 2. Organize work days
- 3. Provide for care of lawm, snow removal, church cleaning.
- 4. Begin to outline a 5 year and 10 year plan.
- 5. Bring to the annual meeting a priortized list of what is anticipated in improvement and mainentance for the coming year.

#### PASTORAL CARE

- 1. Develop a pastoral care team for regular visitation to our members who are shut-ins, in nursing homes, or in the hospital.
- 2. Welcoming and incorporation of newcomers.
- 3. Work with ECW in assisting families in crisis, receptions for funerals, weddings, etc.

#### CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

- 1. Oversight of Sunday School program.
  - a. Curriculum planning
  - b. Sunday School teacher recruitment
- 2. Oversight of adult education
- 3. Help plan necessary training for specialized ministries, e.g. hospital visitation, teacher training, evangelism of new and lapsed members.

## OUTREACH

- 1. Discern particular needs of the community and how Grace Church might respond.
- 2. Ecumenical activities
- 3. Provide assistance in soliciting support for UTO, Presiding Bishop's Fund for World Relief, our voluntary pledge to the Diocese.
- 4. Publicity and Public Relations
  - a. Alpha and Omega
  - b. Articles in SD Churchnews
  - c. Articles in the Madison Daily Leader.
- 5. Ways and means of evangelism of new members
